This incident, recorded only by St. Mark, is so slight and apparently unimportant, that the common opinion is that the young man was St. Mark himself. If so, it is the only mention of him in the Gospels. He is, however, introduced to us in the twelfth chapter of the Acts of the Apostles, being there called John, who is surnamed Mark. His mother's name was Mary, and it was to their home in Jerusalem that St. Peter went immediately after his miraculous delivery from prison by the Angel, and there he found many gathered together. The house apparently was a large one, capable of holding at least a considerable section of the Christian community,...
