The Army Deputy Assistant Secretary for Acquisition, Technology and Logistics issued memoranda linking policy and training and sending a signal to trainers and implementers about the importance of the initiative. The letters to major commands defined the core workforce as contracting officers, contracting officer representatives, program managers, and others. In response to this top-level direction, Army components undertook efforts to get relevant staff trained on performance-based contracting. At the Army Communication - Electronics Command, for example, the commanding general instructed each component to identify and train the relevant workforce on performance-based service contracting and to report progress quarterly. All contracting officers in the commands acquisition organization were required to become current in performance-based service contracting because, according to officials, the organization provides contracting services based on a team concept to many different groups.
