In Chapter III material and material costs are discussed with reference to the practice of a machine shop, or similar metal working industry. The principles which govern purchasing, however, and many relating to receiving, storing and issuing materials, are universal in their application. In Chapter IV on labor costs, the exposition of accounting principles and practice is concerned with work done on definite manufacturing orders (or similar orders for repairs, construction, maintenance, or operating expenses). There are, however, some articles manufactured which for various reasons cannot be conveniently segregated into lots, and their cost of manufacture accumulated on job orders. This is true of some kinds of textiles, the tanning of leather and the manufacture of products by continuous operations, such as flour, brick or cement. Products like...
