This ambitious concept, proposed by Julia Kristeva in the 1960s, shed new light on the understanding and approach to a literary text. Influenced by Bakhtins theory of dialogism, the French scholar suggested a new model of communication which consists of two axes: horizontal, involving communication between subject and addressee, and vertical which is in an interaction between a text and a context. The two axes, as she claimed, coincide which stresses the fact that each word (text) is an intersection of word (texts) where at least one other word (text) can be read (Kristeva in: Allen: 2000, 39). She further drew a conclusion that any text is constructed like a mosaic of quotations; any text is the absorption and transformation of another (Kristeva in: Allen: 2000, 39). Consequently, we can assume that any literary text does...
