Massachusetts-born conservationist and prolific author of children's stories Thornton Waldo Burgess' (1874 - 1965) works are marked by whimsical depiction of nature and animimal life. This volume, sequel to Old Mother West Wind (1910), Mother West Wind's Children (1911) and Mother West Wind's Animal Friends (1912), was written years later in 1965 --- a collection of 15 tales, including why Danny Meadow Mouse's tail is so short, and how it is Reddy Fox has no friends, along with other mysteries in Green Meadow. Characters in the Old Mother West Wind series include Peter Rabbit (briefly known as Peter Cottontail), Jimmy Skunk, Sammy Jay, Bobby Raccoon, Little Joe Otter, Grandfather Frog, Billy Mink, Jerry Muskrat, Spotty the Turtle, Old Mother West Wind and her Merry Little Breezes --- all names that bring smiles to the faces of generations of readers.
